You will gain hands-on experience in producing your own e-book or paperback devotional, learning each step of the publishing process. As we journey together, we will explore Scripture in ways that impact how we think, pray, and live. Two scriptures that reveal God’s desire to assist us spiritually and to reveal truth to us personally are found in these two verses.

“I will pour water on him who is thirsty” (Isaiah 44:3)

“Call upon Me and I will show you great and mighty things you do not know” (Jeremiah 33:3).

Scripture Selection

The passage you choose to write about may be familiar, but the Word of God is inexhaustible. Through prayer and reflection, the Holy Spirit often discloses fresh insights. In this class, you’ll learn how to abide in Jesus as the source of all meaningful written content, allowing your devotionals to flow from spiritual intimacy, not mere technique.

Practical and Technical Skills

You will produce original writing and learn to use WordPress along with basic HTML and CSS to build web pages. While becoming proficient takes time, you'll gain the confidence and foundation to continue developing these skills beyond the course.

You'll also be introduced to key concepts in UI (User Interface) design, typography, and basic marketing—valuable tools for digital evangelism and for expanding personal or ministry opportunities.

Personal Portfolio and Ministry Impact

By the end of the course, you'll have the beginnings of a personal portfolio—your own devotional writing and a basic website to showcase it. These skills are transferable to ministry contexts, personal projects, and even the job market, opening doors for service and potential income streams.

Ministry Collaboration: Together, we will work on a group devotional project for the Women's Ministries Department. This project will combine your creative writing, design, and digital publishing skills. All proceeds from the devotional will go to support women and girls, allowing your learning to make a tangible difference in the lives of others.
